# Medical Provision

## FESTIVAL MEDICAL SERVICES

### **IVY MEAD MEDICAL CENTRE**

Located in Ivy Mead at the top of the site  
Open 1200hrs Wednesday to 1200hrs Monday  
Accident & Emergency Department with full resuscitation facilities  
General Practice surgeries  
Nurse treatment areas  
Physiotherapy  
Chiropody  
Pharmacy

### **PENNARD HILL MEDICAL CENTRE**

Located in Pennard Hill Ground just off the Old Railway Line  
Open 1200hrs Wednesday to 1200hrs Monday  
Medical, nursing and first aid facilities  
Dental surgery

### **GREEN FIRST AID**

Located at entrance to Green Field just off the Old Railway Line  
Open 1200hrs Wednesday to 1200hrs Monday  
First aid facilities

### **MAIN STAGES**

Pit crews covering the pit areas of the two main stages during concert times  
Teams of consultant anaesthetists, paramedics, nurses and first aiders  
Full emergency and resuscitation facilities, first aid

### **DANCE TENT**

Located backstage in Dance Tent  
Open during concert times  
Teams of first aiders with paramedic support – anaesthetist cover available from Main Stages  
Resuscitation, assessment, support and first aid

### **ONE WORLD STAGE**

Located backstage at One World Stage

Open during concert times  
Teams of nurses and first aiders  
Assessment, support and first aid

### **ACOUSTIC STAGE**

Located backstage at Acoustic stage  
Open during concert hours  
Teams of nurses and first aiders  
Assessment, support and first aid

### **MOBILE PIT TEAM**

Available to respond rapidly to requests for medical cover at other stages

### **CONSULTANT OBSTETRICIAN/GYNAECOLOGIST**

Consultant Obstetrician / Gynaecologist on call

### **PSYCHIATRIC TEAM**

Tent adjacent to Main Medical Centre and available to attend psychiatric emergencies around site  
Psychiatrists, psychiatric nurses and drug counsellors  
Assessment, treatment, counselling, observation and support

### **X-RAYS**

Team of radiographers available to accompany casualties to Shepton Mallet Community Hospital for X-ray examinations

### **SITE AMBULANCES**

Fleet of six fwd ambulances  
two paramedic rapid response vehicles

### **OFF-SITE AMBULANCES**

2 road ambulances with paramedic/technician crews to transfer casualties from either Medical Centre to hospital

### **COURIERS**

Collecting equipment, supplies etc.

### **FMS COMMUNICATIONS & CONTROL**

Co-ordination of on-site medical activity and liaison with on and off-site agencies

## **FMS CO-ORDINATION**

### **FMS Medical Director**

Planning, recruitment, negotiation. General oversight and on-site co-ordination of all medical services Assessment and co-ordination of FMS response in the event of a major incident

### **FMS General Manager**

Medical Services infrastructure co-ordination

### **Health & Safety & Emergency Planning Officer**

### **Area Co-ordinators**

## **BEFORE AND AFTER THE EVENT**

### **Paramedic and Site Ambulance cover**

Vehicle crewed by paramedic and driver

Providing emergency cover for the site before and after event (site contractors responsible for their own first aid requirements during this period)

Hours:

Before event: Sunday MD – Wednesday MD

After event: Monday MD – Tuesday 2000hrs

and 0800 – 2000hrs Wednesday - Friday
